

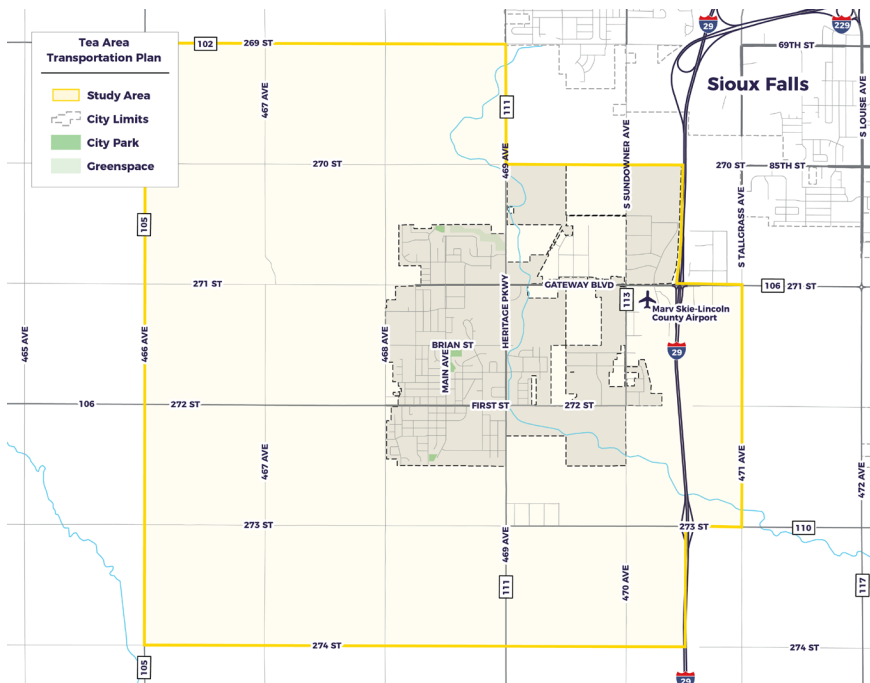
Study Overview

The study team is currently developing the final report and is gathering feedback from the public and area stakeholders to help refine project recommendations.

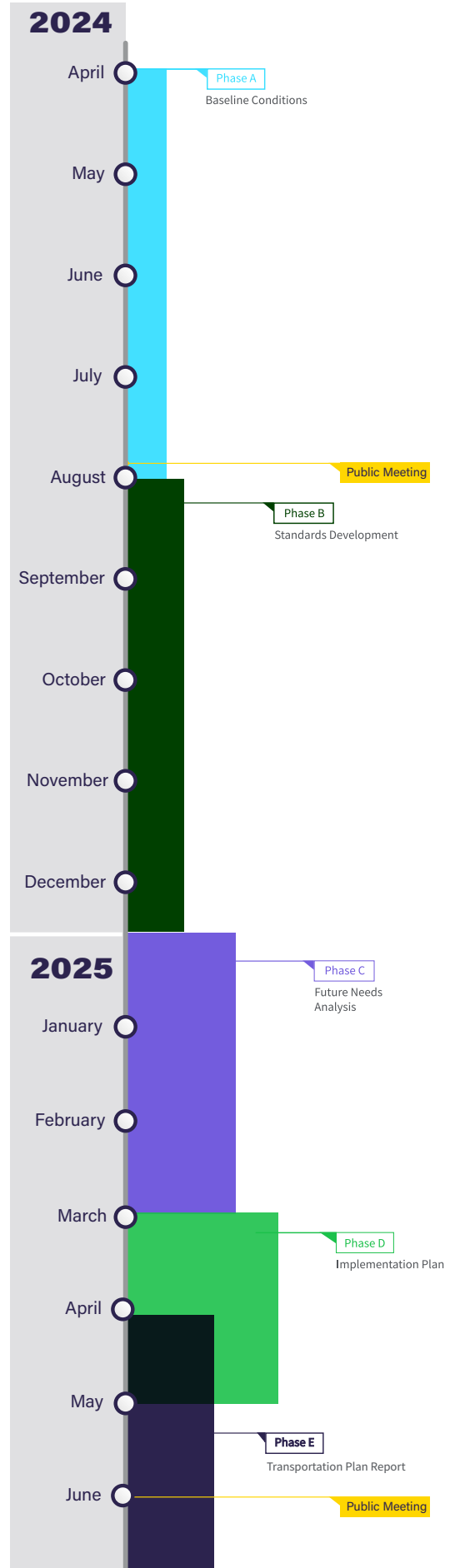

The plan will assess current conditions and create projections to figure out where we are and where we should go.

The TATP will build upon and support the vision being developed in Tea's Comprehensive Plan Update. This Plan is a collaborative effort between the City of Tea, Lincoln County, South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT), Sioux Falls Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), surrounding communities, the public, and study stakeholders.
